- A. <u>Call to Order</u> President Timmers called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.
- B. Additions to the Agenda No additional items were added to the agenda.

After discussion, the \$100 charitable contribution will be given to Cynthia Carrascoc, nominated by her co-worker Svetlana Moure (Garden Grove). Cynthia's young niece was diagnosed with cancer and traveling to see specialists has created a financial burden on the family.

Communications Committee – Robin Brock (Rancho Cucamonga)

The following report was submitted: *Website*: No response from iCentrics. One of the committee's goals is to update the website; until we can discuss what changes are possible with the vendor we cannot move forward. *Fire Circle*: Summer issue distributed in June, and work has started on the Fall edition. *Miscellaneous*: The committee is down two members, leaving a total of three. The logo is being revised by the graphic designer to include Southern or Northern below the AFSS.

The following report was submitted: Contact was made with former committee members to touch base and see who was still interested and able to participate on the committee. The committee will begin the photo project of taking members' pictures to be placed in the membership directory. The majority of the problems with SnapFish have been resolved; pictures at the March and June meeting will be uploaded and fanned out. The committee is working on a variety of projects including scanning all archived documents.

Membership Committee – Liz Dibb (San Miguel)

The following report was submitted: The Membership Drive for 2010/2011 is well underway. They sent out a total of 113 letters to non-member agencies. This year the letters were sent to the administrative support staff instead of the Fire Chiefs. They have

received renewals from 54 members and 1 new member. This new member received the non-member agency letter.

The following report was submitted: The Ways & Means Committee continues to recruit new members. Nancy Haglund has joined the committee. They will continue to sell the current stock of items at the quarterly meetings.

- N. <u>AFSS Logo</u> President Timmers reported that she will be requesting through Communications Committee Coordinator Robin Brock to have the 20th anniversary logo revised with various changes recommended by the executive board.
- O. <u>Ad Hoc Committee</u> President Timmers presented the draft member information survey that will be distributed in September via Survey Monkey.
- P <u>CFCA Conference</u> Karen McCoy reported that they need volunteers for registration and the AFSS Booth. They will be using 100 wine openers with the AFSS logo for giveaways at the booth.

Upon a motion by Valerie Nellis, seconded by Karen McCoy, and unanimously carried, \$100 (which will be split with the North) will be used for candies and the raffle prize.
