# **AFSS Quarterly Meeting Minutes**

## A. Call to Order and Introductions:

## B. Approval of Minutes:

Members reviewed the Minutes of the March 11, 2008 meeting.

# I. Old Business:

#### **Standard Operating Guidelines – Sylvia Diaz**

President Diaz is currently working on the wording. Any recommended changes to the Standard Operating Guidelines should be sent to her before July 11.

### Approval of Bylaw Changes – Sylvia Diaz

President Diaz reported that the following changes were approved by the Joint Executive Board at their April 21 meeting:

Delete Section 2.2 - "2.2 Inactive Members: Inactive members shall be comprised of all persons who have been an Active Member in good standing of the Association upon separation from the Fire

Service. Inactive members shall be entitled to all privileges and benefits provided by the Association, except that they shall not be entitled to vote or hold office."

Add to Section 2.3– "Voting Exception: Any Associate Member who is actively involved as a committee member shall have the right to vote on any issue that is brought before the membership."

Add to Section 2.5– "Voting Exception: Any Life Member who is actively involved as a committee member shall have the right to vote on any issue that is brought before the membership."

Add to Section 3.9.2 – "Any tie vote shall be decided by a second election sent out electronically. If a tie still persists, the position shall be decided by drawing a name at the quarterly meeting prior to the annual conference."

Revise Section 10.1 – "10.1 Changes to the Bylaws may be proposed by any active member and submitted to their respective Bylaws Committee for review and recommendation prior to any Joint Executive Board meeting."

**Motion:** Valerie Nellis moved to approve the revisions to the Bylaws. Alison Guzman-Wulfekuhl seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: 34 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstain.

## J. New Business:

#### **Charitable Contributions – Lisa LeCates**

Lisa LeCates announced that the \$100 quarterly contribution will be donated to the PFC Devin K. P. Cardenas Memorial Foundation.

## September Quarterly Meeting – Sylvia Diaz

Sylvia Diaz reported that the next quarterly meeting will be hosted by Arroyo Grande/Grover Beach Fire Departments and will be held on Friday, September 12, 2008.

#### 2008/09 Budget – Lisa LeCates

Treasurer Lisa LeCates reviewed the 2008/09 proposed budget and requested anyone with changes or additions to submit those to her by June 30.
