CALL TO ORDER: President Barbara Safford called the meeting to order at 1000 hours. Battalion Chief Al Baggio of the Rodeo-Hercules Fire Protection District welcomed members.

CAL FIRE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION LIAISON CHIEF REPORT: Chief Groshong reported that Cal Chiefs' new President, Bill McCammon, is planning a Cal Chiefs meeting January 22 and 23, 2003 in Dixon. AFSS SACRAMENTO WORKSHOP: Committee Budget Chair, Melissa Kositzin, commended Shawn Crawford and JoAnne Lewis for doing a great job on the Sacramento Workshop. The two AFSS divisions will split the \$5,776 profit. A full report will be distributed via Hot Links once all invoices have been received.

First Vice President Shawn Crawford announced that co-chairing the AFSS Workshop was a good experience and a great deal of fun. First Vice President Crawford encouraged two members with similar ideas co-chair the AFSS Workshop in two years. Further, a Workshop Manual is being created to assist future Workshop Chairs.

Second Vice President JoAnne Lewis thanked each of the committees; the Workshop was a group effort.

Historical Committee Co-Chair Kathy Glick reported the AFSS Workshop pictures would be available on CDs.

Education/Training Committee Chair Carol Abraham stated 28 members signed up for future Professional Recognition Programs.
